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
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4th Grade Line Plot Worksheets

Jenny plotted the variation of students that appeared on different days in the blood donation camp organized in the school. The variation is shown below in line plot.




Answer the following questions based on the information shown above.

- 4) Find the number of days where number of students were higher than 12.


Ronald and his friends drew 4 different shapes on their sheet various times and plotted the types of shapes in the line plot with respect to number of times a single shape came in the sheet.

- 1. The name **Cartesian** comes from the French mathematician and philosopher René Descartes, who worked to merge <u>algebra</u> and Euclidean geometry.
- 2. The idea of this system was developed in 1637 in two works by Descartes.
- 3. Cartesian coordinate system is a coordinate system used to place points on a <u>cartesian plane</u> using two numbers, usually called the *x*-coordinate and the *y*-coordinate.
