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
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# 4th Grade Line Plot Worksheets

- 4) Which vehicle passed him the least?


Lucas was serving beverages in coffee shop. Shown below are the types of beverages ordered that day.

- 1. The name **Cartesian** comes from the French mathematician and philosopher René Descartes, who worked to merge <u>algebra</u> and Euclidean geometry.
- 2. The idea of this system was developed in 1637 in two works by Descartes.
- 3. Cartesian coordinate system is a coordinate system used to place points on a <u>cartesian plane</u> using two numbers, usually called the *x*-coordinate and the *y*-coordinate.
