Q.3) The sum of two numbers is 8375. If one of them is 4532, find the other.

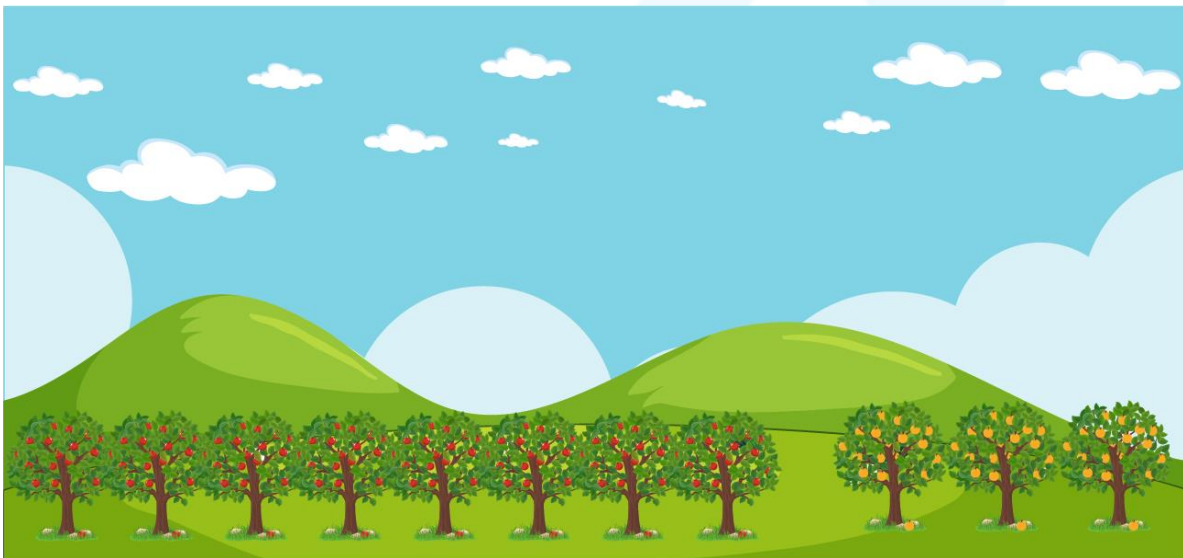
Q.4) Add the largest 5-digit number to the smallest 4-digit number.

## FUN FACT

1. Do you know that when we subtract 0 from any number, the difference is the number itself? For example,  $788 - 0 = 788$ .
2. When 1 is subtracted from any number, you get the previous number, or the predecessor. For example,  $69 - 1 = 68$ .
3. When 1 is added to a number, we get the next number, or the successor. For example,  $414 + 1 = 415$ .
