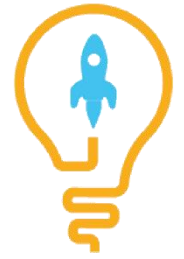

FUN FACT

1. Do you know that when we subtract 0 from any number, the difference is the number itself? For example, $8 - 0 = 8$.
2. When 1 is subtracted from any number, you get the previous number, or the predecessor. For example, $6 - 1 = 5$.
3. When 1 is added to a number, we get the next number, or the successor. For example, $14 + 1 = 15$.
