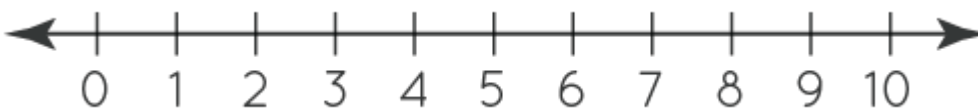

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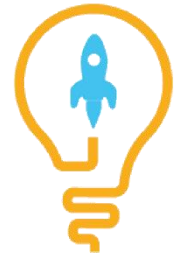

FUN FACT

1. Adding zero to any number gives the number itself. For example, $14 + 0 = 14$.
2. When 1 is added to any number, you get the next number. For example, $5 + 1 = 6$.
3. The order in which you add a group of numbers doesn't matter, the answer is the same. For example, $2 + 5 + 3 = 10$; and $5 + 3 + 2 = 10$.
