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
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Addition Word Problems Worksheets

FUN FACT

- 1. Do you know that when we add 0 to any number, the sum is the number itself? For example, 568 + 0 = 568.
- 2. When 1 is added to a number, we get the next number, or the successor. For example, 140 + 1 = 141.
- 3. Do you know what carry over means? It is a digit that is transferred from one column of digits to another column. For example, when 6 and 7 are added to make 13, the "3" is written in the same column and the "1" is carried to the column to the left.
