The scores in Pete's first two math tests are 75 and 99. By how many points did Pete improve on his second test?

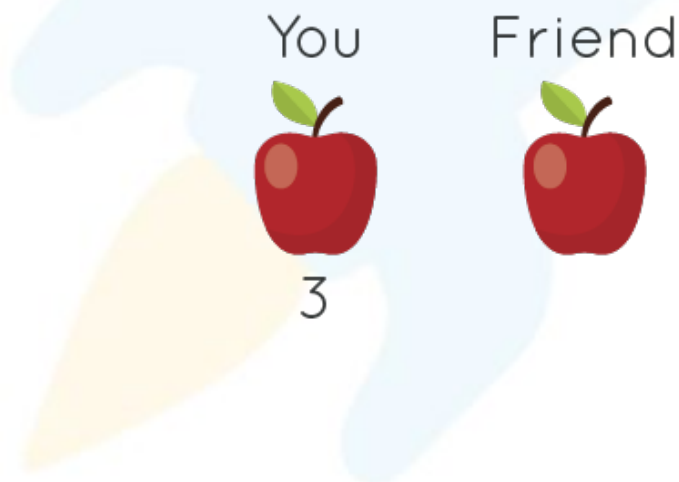

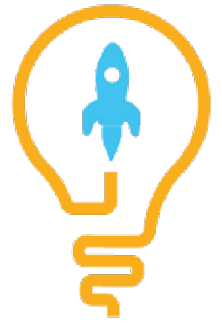
