

**FUN FACT**

1. The oblique bar '/' used to denote division was introduced in 1845 by De Morgan, a British Mathematician.
2. Division does not hold commutative property, i.e.,  $a \div b$  is not equal to  $b \div a$ .
3. Dividing any number by 0 is undefined.
