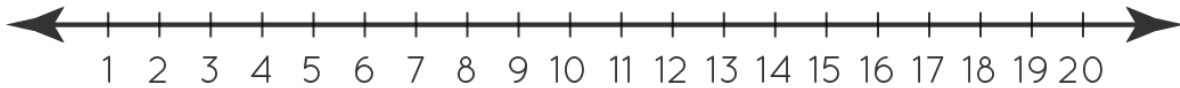

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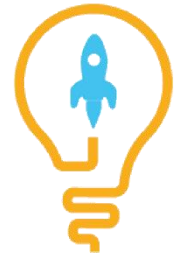

1. Regrouping is another word for 'carry over' in addition and 'borrowing' in subtraction.
