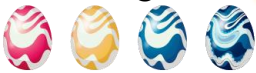

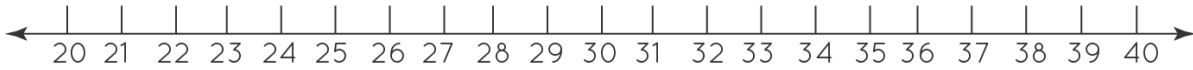

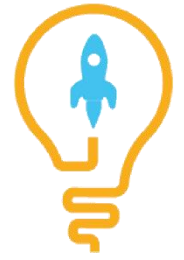

FUN FACT

1. Regrouping is another word for 'carry over' in addition and 'borrowing' in subtraction.
2. Do you know that when we subtract 0 from any number, the difference is the number itself? For example, $17 - 0 = 17$.
3. When 1 is added to any number, you get the next number, or the successor. For example, $36 + 1 = 37$.
