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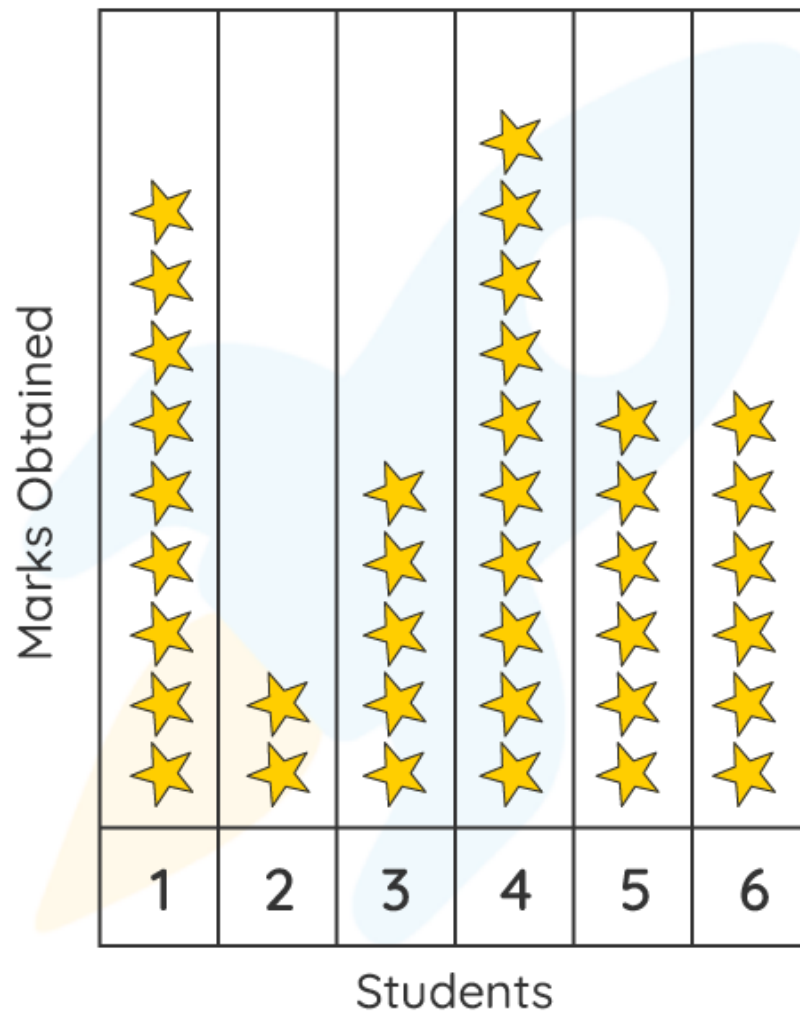
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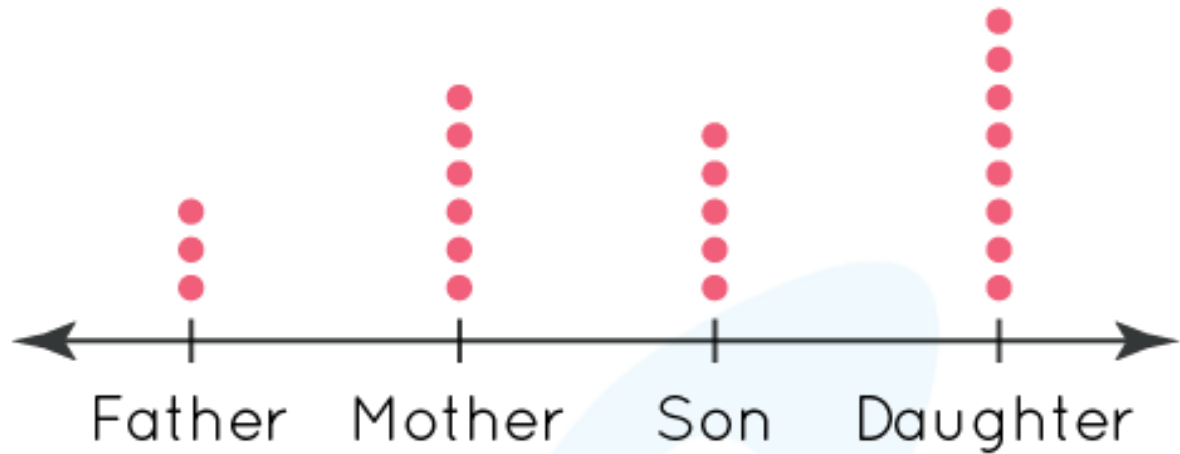
GRAPHING WORKSHEET I

1. The idea of this system was developed in 1637 in two works by Descartes.
