FUN FACT

1. The symbol $>$ is used for comparing numbers and values. The rule is that the wide-open side of the sign always faces the bigger number, whereas the closed end points towards the smaller number.

2. Have you heard about the alligator method? Imagine the symbols ($<$ and $>$) to be the mouth of an alligator, and the numbers on each side as the little fish. Now, the alligator will always want to have more fish. Hence, we write it as, $6 > 3$.
