1. Jennifer gained 3 points in the first round of a game, lost 5 points in the second round and gained 9 points in the third round. What are her total points?
2. Lara burnt 350 calories working out on the treadmill. Later she indulged in a donut that had a calorie count of 400. Did she gain or lose calories?
3. Alex is enjoying playing in the pool. He enjoys jumping from the very cool pool (10 degree celsius) to the hot Jacuzzi (42 degree celsius). What temperature change is Alex experiencing as he moves from pool to Jacuzzi?
4. Joey just got 98 points on a report. However, because he turned it in late, he will have a penalty of -20 points. What will Joey's final score on the report be?
5. In an online practice test, Jack scores 18 points for the questions he answered correctly and gets -2 points for each incorrect answer. Jack answered 3 questions incorrectly. How many points did Jack score?
6. Bryan works as an underwater photographer. He starts at a position that is 15 feet below sea level. He rises 9 feet, then descends 12 feet to take a photo of a coral reef. What is his current depth?

7. The temperature on a winter night was -33 degrees. The temperature rose by 8 degrees when the sun came up. When the sun set again, the temperature dropped by 7 degrees. What is the temperature after the sunset?

8. Jose earned 80 points in a video game. He lost 30 points, earned 97 points, then lost 50 more points. What is his final score in the video game?

9. The temperature of New York City on a certain day is -3°C . The next day, it increases by 2°C . Then what is the temperature on the next day?

10. Ashley's account is credited with \$48 and then debited with \$80. What is her balance?
