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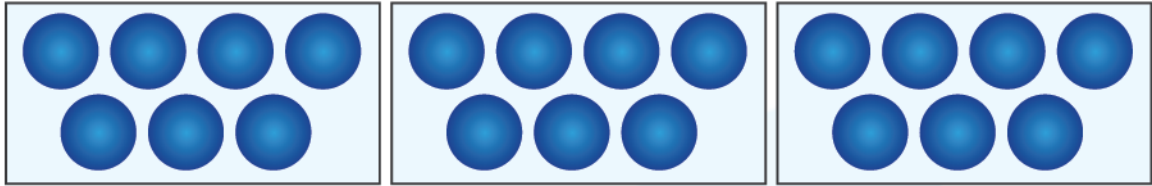
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MULTIPLICATION BY 7 WORKSHEET - 1

1. The word Multiply originated from the Latin word “multiplicō” which means ‘many fold’.
2. Multiplication of any number by 1 result in that number itself.
3. William Oughtred (1576–1660), a mathematician, was the first to use the symbol “x” for multiplication.
