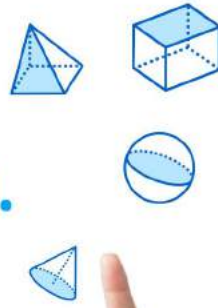


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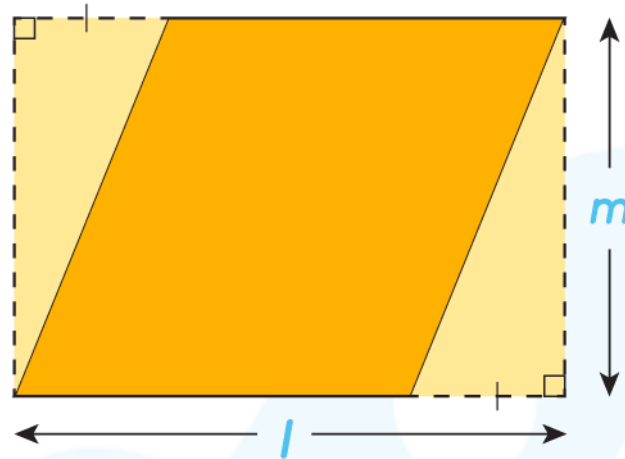
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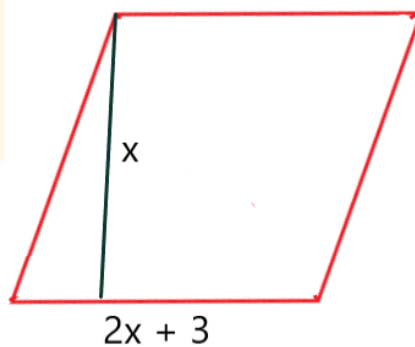
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Parallelogram Worksheet III

Perimeter of a square = $4 \times \text{Side}$.

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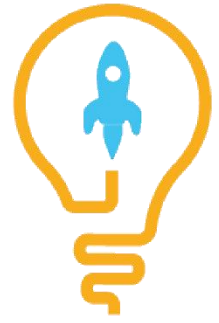
