

## **FUN FACT**

- 1. Rounding off numbers simplifies calculations.
- 2. The number that is rounded off is approximately the same as the initial value.
- 3. When you round off a number to the nearest hundred, check the number in the tens place. If it is 5 or more, round up to the next hundred, if it is 4 or less than 4, round down to the previous hundred.
