FUN FACT

1. Do you know that when we subtract 0 from any number, the difference is the number itself? For example, $8 - 0 = 8$.
2. When 1 is subtracted from any number, you get the previous number, or the predecessor. For example, $6 - 1 = 5$.
3. Words such as "Minus", "Less", "Difference", "Decrease", "Take Away" and "Deduct" mean that you need to subtract one number from the other.
