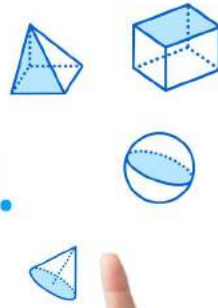

FUN FACT

1. To subtract numbers, we first arrange them in place value columns and then subtract the digits under ones, tens and hundreds columns.
2. While performing subtraction, the smaller number is always subtracted from the larger number.
3. First we perform a subtraction on the numbers in the Units column on the right, then write the answer at the bottom in the same column.
